### Driving to No.1 Mann Island

Mann Island is located close to The Strand which links the city centre with the A561 to the north and the A562 to the south. These main roads then connect with the main ring road, Queens Drive (A5058). Nearby motorways are the M57 to the north, the M62 to the east and the M53 from the Wirral via the Kingsway Tunnel.

### Trains to No.1 Mann Island

Mainline trains arrive in the city at Liverpool Lime Street and any Wirral Line train from Lime Street underground station will take you to James Street which is less than 200m away from our offices. Alternatively there are taxis at Lime Street or the walk should take no more than 15mins.

### Buses to No.1 Mann Island

Many bus routes serve the area around Mann Island. Liverpool ONE Bus Station is located about 600m away. There is also a main bus and rail interchange on James Street, less than 200m away.

### Parking

The Capital car park is only a couple of minutes walk from Mann Island. It has two entrances situated on The Strand and Old Hall Street and has more than 1,000 spaces.

There are also car parks close by: Q-Park Strand Street has 2000 spaces and is accessible from the centre of the road. Q-Park Gradwell Street has 560 spaces and is opposite BBC Radio Merseyside on Hanover Street, and Q-Park John Lewis has 580 spaces and is located opposite the Paradise Street bus interchange and the police station.
