## LOOKING BACK - OUTCOME FROM 2010/11 PLAN:

The Waste Facilities Section has continued to provide a planning, design, contract procurement, maintenance and environmental monitoring service relating to: existing and new waste management facilities; and environmental control works at the Authority's closed landfill sites.

It has continued to have an active role in the Authority maintaining ISO 14001 (Environmental Management System) accreditation and continues to monitor and manage its activities in accordance with approved procedures.

The projects identified in the 2010/11 Service Plan are ongoing with relevant progress and defrayed expenditure being reported in the quarterly monitoring reports relating to capital expenditure.

The set performance target for undertaking scheduled maintenance activities at the Authority's closed landfill sites was successfully achieved. However, the aim to provide a replacement site for the existing Kirkby HWRC in 2010/11 was not achieved due to delays associated with post planning approval conditions.
