## Joint Recycling and Waste Management Strategy (JRWMS) - Joint Working Consultation

- 1. Sefton is best placed to determine the precise nature and timing of investment in Waste Collection systems in order to maximise our contribution to the JRWMS targets.
- 2. That having considered the legal advice and proposal for the creation and distribution of the development fund Sefton has no objections to the proposal, should it be implemented.
